
Angel's Island




Newspaper Furniture


It is not about Form at all, it is about the Idea.


Here the concept is about recycling the newspaper and turning it into a piece of furniture, which is not developed for permanent use but for cases with the least life cycle. For example, we buy single-use cups for parties, so why we don't have this type of stuff in furniture? It is basically made of a thin aluminum structure molded with newspaper pulp, just like a newspaper pencil (with graphite inside instead). It can be easily mass-produced and sold at the cheapest price. This product is affordable and environmentally friendly.






Cocolin

Human needs connected with nature

Urban space is affected by many objects. One of the most seen items is trash bins, so I decided to design a trash bin, considering urban problems with it and also somehow being not so far from nature. It is inspired by the cocoon shape and color.




Major problems with similar public trash cans

- Trash bag getting stuck into the bin
- The way parts join, could tear the bag
- Low volume space, less than 40L
- Outer body couldn't be produced easily
- It could not be easily located at night
- Liquid leak at the bottom of the container
- Bag displacement was a big trouble


Solutions offered by the Designed Object

- Form of the container is designed curvy to prevent the bag from getting stuck or teared
- The body has an efficient volume of 60 liters and can be produced with least effort
- The solid part at the bottom prevents leakage and is also equipped with LED for night
- Round metal wire would hold the bag inside, preventing it from any displacement










Bonchair




Whale tail
